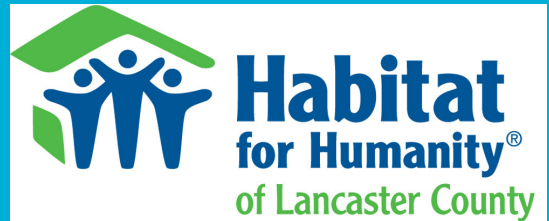

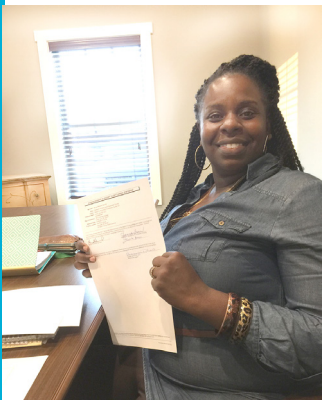

- **Springs Close Extends CHR Program with new \$2,500 Grant.** Our Critical Home Repair program is expanding as demand increases. It's designed to help senior, disabled and veteran households, when they can't afford needed repairs. Special thanks to the Sun City Habitat Friends Club for coordinating and evaluating these projects, with project assistance from YouthBuild, partnership with H & S Roofing, and help from City and County government. Cecil Mangum has a new wheelchair ramp, the Carnes family has a safe front porch, and other completed repair projects enabled 14 more families to remain in their homes. this year.



- **Rehab Becomes Samuel's New Home.** Marivette Samuel helped rehab a home and became our newest Habitat homeowner in November, 2016.
- **Promise Neighborhood.** Habitat is proud to partner with many other organizations in the community to help revitalize the Promise Neighborhood in Lancaster. One of our contributions is paint for Promise homes, provided through Habitat's Gift in Kind partnership with Valspar.
